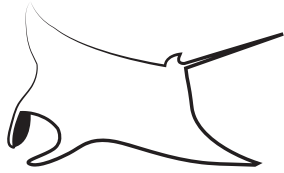
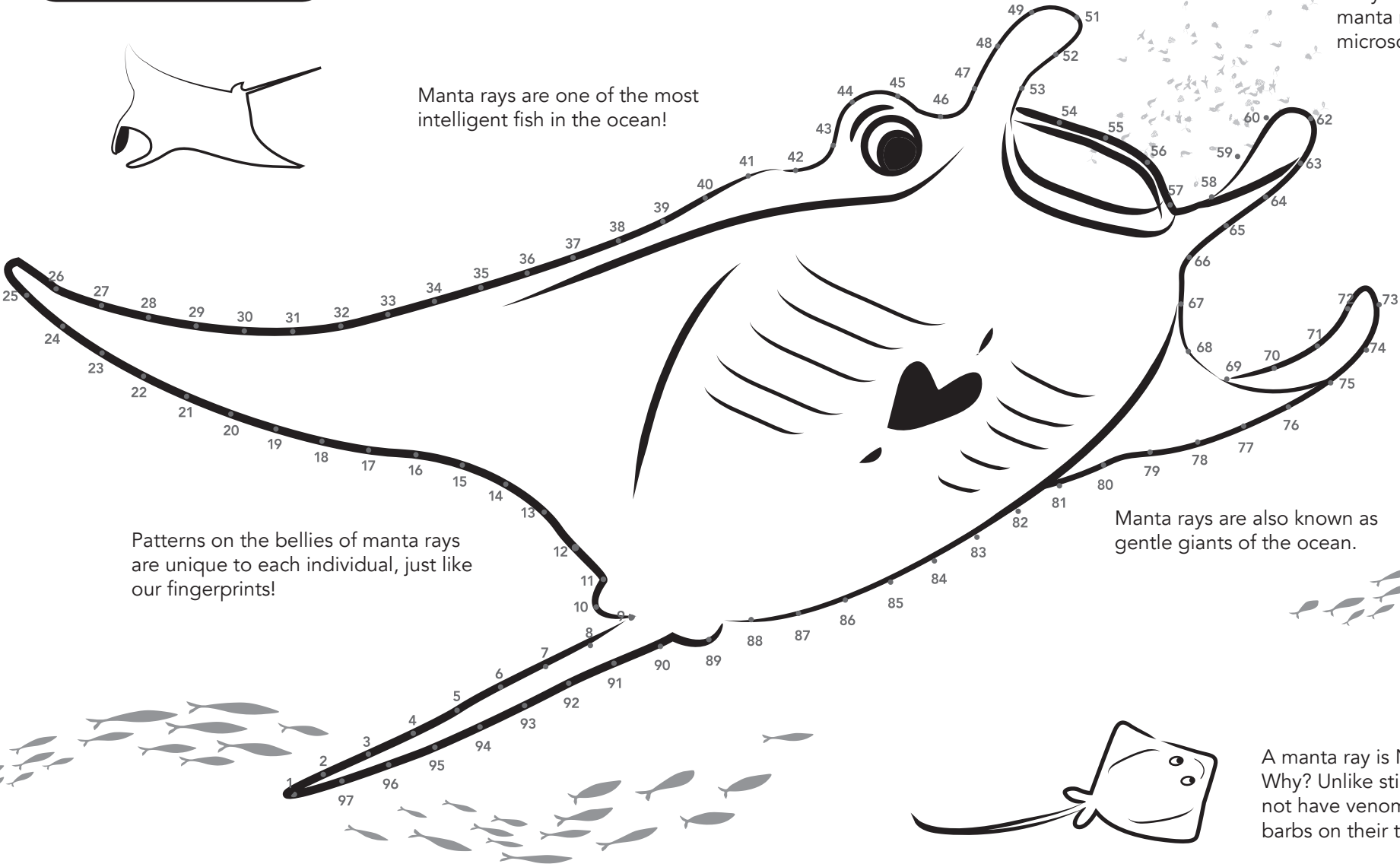


MANTA RAY



Manta rays are one of the most intelligent fish in the ocean!

They may be large, but manta rays feed on tiny, microscopic plankton!



Patterns on the bellies of manta rays are unique to each individual, just like our fingerprints!

Manta rays are also known as gentle giants of the ocean.

A manta ray is NOT a stingray! Why? Unlike stingrays, they do not have venomous stinging barbs on their tails!

POISON ARROW FROG

Only found in the Amazonian rainforest along the Pacific coast of Colombia, the golden poison frog is best known for being the most toxic frog." An individual can contain enough toxins to kill 10 adults!



Beautiful but deadly - bright colours on the frog signal "Don't eat me! I'm poisonous!"

Frogs are amphibians. Most amphibians spend the first part of their lives in water (breathe using gills) and eventually head out of the water to live on land (breathe using lungs)!

Where do poison arrow frogs live? They can be found hiding under leaves and logs in South American rainforests!
